

## **FIRST CLASS CAMP REMINDERS:**

- 1. 1 week before, write a checklist of everything you need to bring. Review it the night before leaving for camp.
- 2. Don't be afraid to write lists to help you remember and plan better
- 3. If something is going wrong: <u>STOP! Re-think, Re-group and Re-direct</u>
  - a. Don't be afraid to stop what you're doing and start over from the beginning. Don't worry about what you already have invested. You'll be better off in the end if you do.
  - b. Remember: the troop is looking for maturity and how you handle a crisis.
- 4. When in doubt, look it up in your **Boy Scout Handbook**
- 5. <u>Check</u> all lashings and knots. Check each other's work. Give advice and accept criticism.
- 6. Keep your site neat and clean, make it look like a picture perfect site
- 7. Keep yourself neat and clean
- 8. Don't be afraid to ask questions
- **9.** Don't do something just to "get by" or to "hurry up and get done with it." <u>Take your time and do it right!</u>
- 10.If you're allowed and have time, take an hour off and participate in the troops weekend program to help you relax.
- 11.Remember: no matter what, **have fun!** That's what it's all about.
