



## **FIRST CLASS CAMP REMINDERS:**

1. 1 week before, write a checklist of everything you need to bring. Review it the night before leaving for camp.
2. Don't be afraid to **write lists** to help you remember and plan better
3. If something is going wrong: **STOP! Re-think, Re-group and Re-direct**
  - a. Don't be afraid to stop what you're doing and start over from the beginning. Don't worry about what you already have invested. You'll be better off in the end if you do.
  - b. Remember: the troop is looking for maturity and how you handle a crisis.
4. When in doubt, look it up in your **Boy Scout Handbook**
5. **Check** all lashings and knots. Check each other's work. Give advice and accept criticism.
6. Keep your site **neat and clean**, make it look like a picture perfect site
7. Keep yourself neat and clean
8. Don't be afraid to ask questions
9. Don't do something just to "get by" or to "hurry up and get done with it."  
**Take your time and do it right!**
10. If you're allowed and have time, take an hour off and participate in the troops weekend program to help you relax.
