



Great Trail Council Adult Leader Application 2021 National Scout Jamboree



The Great Trail Council will have three contingent boy troops and one girl troop for the 2021 National Scout Jamboree. There are several key requirements for each of the adult leader positions in each troop which are detailed below. A Council Selection Committee will interview & select up to 8 adult spots for each troop.

A fundamental requirement is the willingness and ability to dedicate significant time and effort to recruit youth participants and prepare the contingent for the jamboree.

Monthly meetings and several weekend orientations, participant training and youth leader training sessions will be conducted in order to insure that the contingent is prepared for an experience of a lifetime. Additionally, communications, logistics, equipment planning and project management are important factors.

In addition to the position specific requirements the general requirements are:

All Adult Leaders

- ◆ **Completed and have current credentials in all of the following as of July 1, 2021: Youth Protection, Weather Hazard, Safety Afloat, Safe Swim Defense, and Red Cross CPR/First Aid. For SM/ASM1/ASM2 positions Scoutmaster Specific, and Scoutmaster Outdoor are required. (Other trainings may be required per the National Jamboree.)**
- ◆ Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.
- ◆ Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- ◆ Have filed with and been accepted by both council and National, the Jamboree Personal Health and Medical Record before the pre-jamboree training events.
- ◆ Be approved by the Council Jamboree Committee.

*The below positions are samples of what type of positions will be available for the Jamboree.

Scoutmaster

- ◆ Have served as or be currently registered as a Scoutmaster on July 1, 2021.

First Assistant Scoutmaster (Troop Activities)

- ◆ Be at least 21 years of age by July 1, 2021.
- ◆ Be registered as and have served as an Assistant Scoutmaster or Scoutmaster on July 1, 2021.

Second Assistant Scoutmaster (Physical Arrangements)

- ◆ Be at least 21 years of age by July 1, 2021.
- ◆ Be registered as and serve as an active Assistant Scoutmaster or Scoutmaster on July 1, 2021.

Third Assistant Scoutmaster

- ◆ Be at least 18 years of age (but not yet 21) by August 1, 2021.
- ◆ Have served actively in a troop leadership position.
